

- 1) This document defines terms and conditions for the use of the PROFINETSET software package (hereinafter "Software"), a tool designed to aid in troubleshooting and integration of industrial Ethernet/PROFINET networks.
- 2) The owners of proprietary rights to the Software are Mr. Paweł Filipek and Mr. Jan Mazan who run their business in the form of the civil partnership called JPEmbedded s.c. with its registered office in Cracow as well as the INTEX Limited Liability Company with its registered office in Gliwice (hereinafter "Authors"). No proprietary rights or intellectual property rights to the Software shall be transferred under terms of this License since such rights shall remain the property of the Authors.
- 3) Download of the Software and its further use shall be deemed as acceptance of the terms and conditions contained herein.
- 4) In order to download the software the user has to provide his/her e-mail address. An e-mail message containing the link to the site where the Software can be downloaded will be sent to the provided address. The e-mail address will be also used to advise the user about possible upgrades of the Software. At any moment of time the user may resign from sending of messages to the e-mail address initially provided.
- 5) The license for the Software is free of charge, non-exclusive, unlimited in terms of area and time of use and refers to the specific revision of the Software.
- 6) Users of the Software are entitled to:
 - a) use the Software on more than one appliance,
 - b) make backup copies of the Software for their own needs within the scope of the possessed license,
 - c) receive from the Authors further upgrades of the software, if any are released. The Authors reserve the rights to publish new revisions of the Software on the website of the Company [www.profinetset.com]. New revisions of the Software may offer new functionalities.
- 7) Users of the Software are not entitled to:
 - a) make the Software available upon payment to any third parties,
 - b) publish the Software in any form except for demonstrations,
 - c) use the Software for any other purposes except for troubleshooting and integration of industrial Ethernet/PROFINET networks with use of equipment dedicated to these applications.
- 8) The Authors made all possible efforts to provide correct and fault-free operation of the Software. However, no guarantees can be given to users of the Software with regard to flawless operation of the Software.
- 9) Users of the Software are not entitled to charge-free technical support with regard to use of the Software.
- 10) Users of the Software is responsible for use of the Software in accordance with the intended purpose and in adherence to the terms and conditions of this License Agreement.
- 11) Authors reserve the right to amend terms and conditions of the License Agreement as set forth herein. Each user is bound by the terms and conditions of the License Agreement of the Software revision actually operated by the specific user.
- 12) Authors shall not be held liable for any damages that may arise from or in connection with the use of the Software under terms and conditions of this License Agreement; in particular they decline any financial liability with regard to equipment or other assets of the user. Such damages include any loss or damage of data as well as loss of profit that may arise from inability to use the Software for specific purposes.
- 13) The Authors are unable to guarantee that the Software satisfies all requirements of users with regard to specific applications. It is the User's responsibility to get familiar with all options and functionalities of the Software to make sure that the Software is suitable for the User's needs.
- 14) Should the user fail to adhere to the terms and conditions of this License Agreement, all obligations of the Authors and all rights granted to the user under the terms of this License Agreements are instantly terminated. In addition, if the user breaches the obligations specified in Sections 7 a-c, the Authors shall be entitled to call the user to account for such a breach.

- 16) Any issues that are not covered by this License Agreement shall be treated in accordance with rules and regulations of Polish law, in particular the Act of 4th February 1994 on copyright and related rights.
- 17) These Terms of Use are governed by the laws of Poland and will be interpreted in accordance with the Polish courts. The District Court for Kraków Śródmieście in Kraków shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any litigation action or dispute which might arise out of or in connection with these terms of use.
